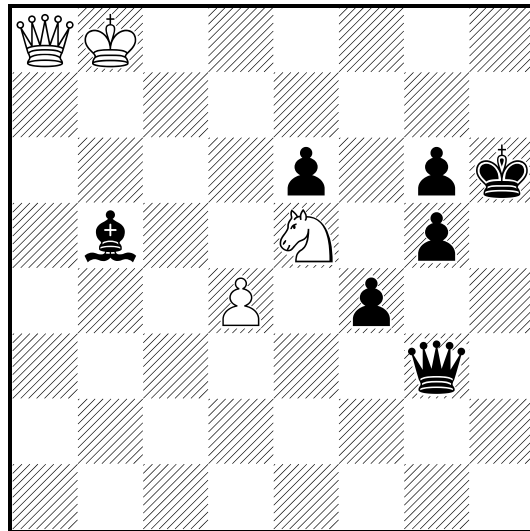

3. ♜f7 ♕e8!
